



Description of the Participant School – 2 in the Czech Republic

Základní škola Fr. Plamínkové is a state school specializing in language education. The school is located close to the city centre and is a selective school (children aged 5 must sit an aptitude test to enroll). All extra lessons which Framework Education Programme allows school to use with respect to their specialization, are used for extra language lessons. The school is for pupils from 1st to 9th grade, there are about 350 pupils in total. It offers a wide variety of extra curricular activities.

The school is a partner school of Charles University in Prague, Faculty of Education. Its staff is very dynamic and enthusiastic about trying new methodologies and getting involved in different projects and piloting various activities. They are used to cooperation.

The pupils take part in several competitions (national and international). The school also regularly organizes trips abroad.
